

## **RULES FOR CLOBRYN POOL**

- Fishing for members and valid day ticket holders only. All Anglers must have a valid EA rod licence. These will be randomly checked. Members to act as bailiffs.
- All anglers must come to the pool with a clean and dry landing net. **NO LANDING NET = NO FISHING!**
- All fish above 2 ounces to be landed and returned to the water with a landing net.
- Unhooking mats must be used.
- Fishing from pegs only.
- Fishing is from dawn till dusk only – **No** Night Fishing.
- Only 1 rod or pole is to be used by any angler at any time.
- Children under the age of 16 must accompanied and supervised by and adult at all times.
- Maximum line strength is 8lb with a lighter strength hook length to be used.
- Barbless hooks only. Size 14 maximum.
- Ground bait is allowed up to 1Kg per angler per session.
- The gate to the car park must be kept locked at all times.
- Dogs are to be kept under control and on a lead, and all mess to be bagged and taken away.
- Smoking is permitted, but all smokers must safely extinguish cigarettes/cigars and take butts home with them.
- During match days no member or day ticket holder is allowed to pleasure fish before or during a match. Match dates will be posted on the club's website.
- **No** fishing over halfway on the lake from your peg.
- **No** night fishing permitted. No camping or bivvies allowed.
- **No** electronic bite alarms to be used.
- **No** fires, BBQ's or cooking permitted.
- **No** alcohol is to be consumed at Clobryn Pool and no one intoxicated is to be permitted access.
- **No** litter is to be left. Leave the pool cleaner than when you arrived. Excess bait and waste tackle must be taken home.
- **No** braided line allowed
- **No** fixed rigs when ledgering. Running rigs only.
- **No** fishing inside the lily pads.
- **No** keep nets allowed - except in matches and during population control under guidance of NRW licence. These must be clean and dry.
- **No** rods or baited hooks to be left unattended at any time. If you move away from your peg reel your rod in.
- **No** floating baits – this includes no floating bread. Small punched sunken bread only is permitted.
- **No** bloodworm or jokers allowed. The use of hempseed is allowed.
- **No** tins of bait to be taken to the pool. Please use proper bait containers.
- **No** fish to be introduced or removed from Clobryn Pool unless stocking under the control of the CEFAS licence or population control under the NRW license.

**ANY ANGLER IN BREACH OF ANY OF THESE RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE POOL AND MAY BE BANNED! MEMBERS COULD HAVE THEIR MEMBERSHIP TAKEN OFF THEM!**
